Our Mission

Friends of NRA is a grassroots fundraising program conducted under the NRA Foundation, a 501(c)(3) non-profit that raises tax-deductible contributions in support of a wide range of firearm-related public interest activities of the National Rifle Association of America and other organizations that defend and foster the Second Amendment rights of all law-abiding citizens.

Supported Programs

100% of net profits are awarded to fund programs supporting firearms safety and education, hunting education, enhanced marksmanship, competitive shooting, range development, disabled shooter services, and the like. Half of the money raised by Friends of NRA committees stays in the state in which it was raised while the other half funds programs on a national scale.

Grant Recipients

In 2018, the 26 *Friends of NRA* chapters in Virginia awarded \$426K raised from our previous year's events to qualified state recipients. Recipients in our area include:

The other \$424K raised was awarded to fund national programs such as Refuse To Be a Victim, Hunter Education, Eddie Eagle GunSafe, Women On Target, and many others.
