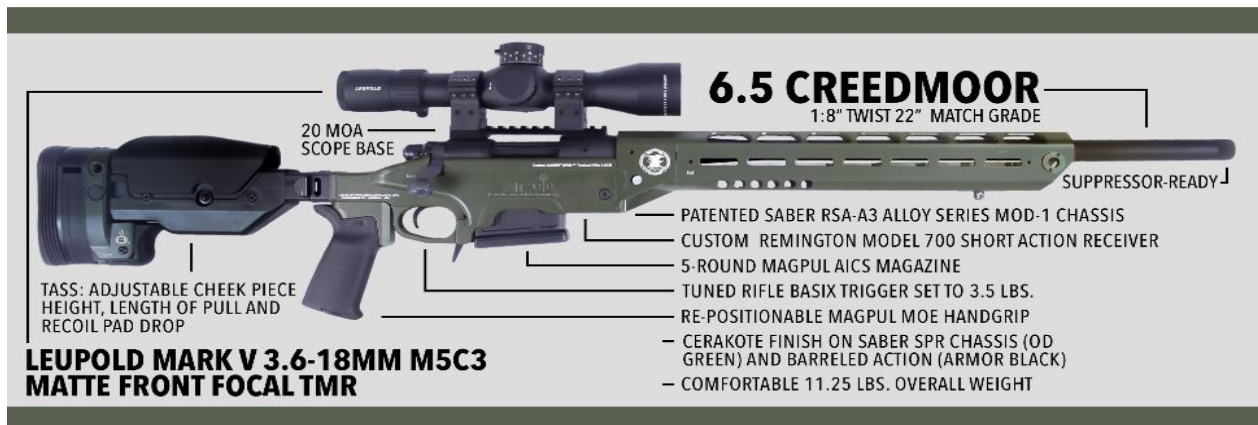

Known as the father of the modern U.S. Marine Corps sniper program, retired USMC Major and past NRA Secretary Edward J. "Jim" Land Jr. is internationally renowned for his expertise in precision firearms. In 1961 Land founded the Corps' first modern Sniper Course and went on to create and command its highly successful tactical field program in Vietnam. Ultimately, the formal sniper school at Quantico Marine Corps base stands as a lasting legacy of Land's efforts.

After retiring as a Major in 1977, Maj. Land—a Double Distinguished Marksman and NRA-certified instructor—proceeded to serve the NRA as a field representative and a director of two divisions before being elected to the NRA board of directors and then serving as NRA Secretary from 1994-2015.



In this unique tribute to a man of distinguished service and significant impact, a photo of Maj. Land from his days as a U.S. Marine accompany a biographical note and a 6.5 Creedmoor casing fired by the major from one of 50 exclusive, custom-built Saber M700 Major E. J. Land Signature Edition Tactical Rifles from APO. Each rifle is individually numbered and bears Major Land's engraved signature along with the NRA seal.
