History of Friends of NRA

Friends of NRA started in 1992 by some “friends” of the NRA from Columbia, Missouri who wanted to throw a fundraising party for the NRA. It was an exploratory idea to help build and promote the newly established NRA Foundation and to empower the grassroots base of NRA supporters looking for ways to support and promote NRA training and educational programs. This group of “friends” started meeting regularly and realized they needed a name for this inaugural event. Looking around the room of “friends,” one person spoke up and said, “this is a no brainer – call it, Friends of NRA.” That inaugural fundraising event was widely successful and kicked into high gear the following year with 21 field representatives and 189 events grossing \$2.7 million! Over a quarter of a century later, we’re embarking on the billion dollar mark due to a few “friends” and their fundraising vision for a stronger tomorrow.
