

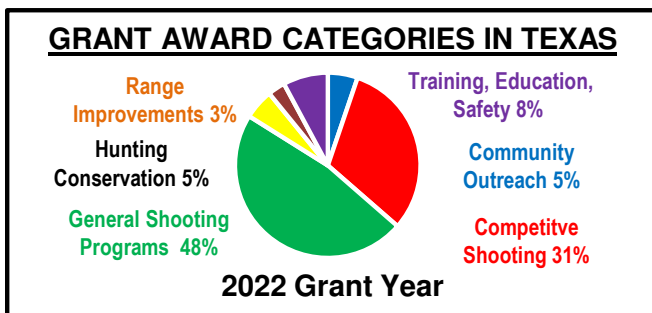


The NRA Foundation Grant Program

Since 1992, Friends of NRA has conducted events to raise funds to support The NRA Foundation, a 501(c)(3) charitable organization, all with the help of dedicated volunteers. The NRA Foundation then allocates half of all net proceeds to fund projects within the state in which the money was raised and uses the other half to fund projects on a national scope. Established in 1990, The NRA Foundation is a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt organization that raises tax-deductible contributions in support of a wide range of firearm-related public interest activities of the National Rifle Association of America and other organizations that defend and foster the Second Amendment rights of all law-abiding Americans. These activities are designed to promote firearms and hunting safety, to enhance marksmanship skills of those participating in the shooting sports, and to educate the general public about firearms in their historic, technological, and artistic context. Funds granted by The NRA Foundation benefit a variety of constituencies throughout the United States, including children, youth, women, individuals with physical disabilities, gun collectors, law enforcement officers, hunters, and competitive shooters.
