## FRIENDS OF NRA

Friends of NRA is a 100% grassroots program fueled by a united front to secure the Second Amendment and raise money for the shooting sports. Nothing makes a Friends of NRA event more unique than the **8,000 dedicated volunteers** who work tirelessly to make these events happen.

With support from the NRA Field Staff, thousands of passionate volunteers committed to the future of the shooting sports participate in the program by organizing committees, securing donations, selling tickets, and hosting Friends of NRA events in their communities. Whether you're serving on the committee or attending with family and friends, you'll meet committed citizens working together to protect our American freedoms for the next generation.

Friends of NRA events boil down to one goal—fundraising for the future of the shooting sports. Since its inception in 1992, Friends of NRA has held over **26,000 events**, reached over **4.9 million attendees** and raised more than **\$1.2 billion gross** to support shooting sports programs across the country.

## FUNDING THE FUTURE

Friends of NRA provides critical funding for educational firearm programs at the local, state, and national levels. These grants support program growth, improve instructional resources, and strengthen the overall impact of shooting sports and safety education to millions of Americans.

Every year, half of all net event proceeds are allocated for use by the state in which it was raised. Friends of NRA volunteers are appointed to State Fund Committees who then make recommendations on how the local grant funding is dispersed. The other half is used to fund NRA operations and projects similar to those on the local and state levels, but with a national scope. These monies sustain vital programs such as youth and women's programs, range services, the Eddie Eagle GunSafe® program, education & training, law enforcement, competitive shooting, hunter safety & services, the National Firearms Museum, and NRA School Shield.

## SUPPORTED PROGRAMS

Friends of NRA recognizes that the future of our shooting traditions lies in programs that inspire and encourage individuals to further develop their passion for firearm education and training.

Grants benefit programs such as youth education, women-focused clinics, law enforcement training, hunter safety, range improvement, and firearms and marksmanship training and safety. Recognizing the impact American youth has on the future of the shooting sports, State Fund Committees frequently recommend grants for youth programs, allocating the most significant portion of monies to this vital area.
